In addition, the knowledge of effective strategies that address common problems and reduce duplication of effort will be increased. With this improved and readily available information, the preparation of grant proposals and reports will be simplified</p>

EVALUATION—The following results will be measured: Number of agencies entering data into *Community Link*; the usefulness of data as measured by the number of individuals using the entered data on *Community Link*.
